POLICY STATEMENT:

Council policy is that all roads identified pursuant to Part 12.3 of the Local Government Act (**Act**) within the municipality should be maintained.

PROCESS

Council will pursuant to Section 186 (5) of the **Act** maintain the road easement

1. through a process of clearing vegetation in an appropriate manner
 - a) slashing
 - b) spraying
2. clearing of rubbish/litter
3. removal of vehicles or other hazards
4. maintenance of infrastructure (road signage, etc)

Council will allocate funding for the above process within its annual budget through the Infrastructure and Environmental Programs

PERIOD COVERED BY THE POLICY

This Policy is adopted as part of the Business Plan and applies to all financial years to the next Local Government Election in 2016 unless amended.
