Nomination Guidelines

On Monday 26 January 2026 Australians all around the country will celebrate what's great about Australia. We would like you to help us celebrate what's great about our community by nominating someone you know for a Local Government Australia Day Award.

Pay tribute to someone who makes you proud to be an Australian, be it a friend, family member, workmate or someone you have met while serving the community, and nominate them for a Litchfield Council Community Award.

The Award categories that you may nominate in are:

- Litchfield Citizen of the Year: This award recognises a citizen 30 years and over who has demonstrated an outstanding achievement for the Litchfield Community.
- Litchfield Young Citizen of the Year: This award recognises a young citizen up to 29 years who has demonstrated an outstanding achievement for the Litchfield Community.
- Litchfield Community Event of the Year: This award recognises a Community Event that has made a significant and outstanding contribution to the Litchfield Community in the current year or over a number of years.

HOW TO NOMINATE:

Please complete the attached form. Supporting documentation may also be provided with your nomination form if you feel it will assist the judges in making their decision. Please do not supply originals of supporting documentation, as all documentation will be retained by Litchfield Council. Ensure the nominee is willing to accept the nomination. The award winners are invited to attend Council events throughout the year.

ELIGIBILITY:

All nominees must be an Australian citizen and reside in the Litchfield Community at the time of nomination and be an active member in the Litchfield Community.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Please consider the selection criteria listed below when completing your nomination:

- Confirm that the person / event is actively involved in the Litchfield Community.
- How has the person/event made an outstanding positive contribution to the Litchfield Community?
- How has the person/event been an inspiration for the community?
- How has the person/event demonstrated a commitment to enhancing the Litchfield Community?
- Why do you believe that this person/event should receive an Australia Day Award?

AWARD PRESENTATION:

Nominees will receive a formal letter of acknowledgment confirming receipt of their nomination. Nominees and nominators will receive invitations to the official award ceremony on Monday 26 January 2026 where the winners will be announced.
