# **Executive Summary**

Total revenue of \$124,121 as of the end of August reflects an increase in both cremations and burials and this represents 14% of the annual budget.

Total year to date expenses of \$121,723 is 13% of the annual budget.

Final accruals and end of year reconciliation are still outstanding. Financial year results will be reported in Council's Annual report by November 2020.
