Executive Summary

Total revenue of \$344,757 as of the end of September reflects an increase in both cremations and burials and represents 37% of the budgeted revenue

Total year to date expenses of \$186,731 is 20% of the budgeted expenditure.

Final accruals and end of year reconciliation are still outstanding. Financial year results will be reported in Council's Annual report by November 2020.
